Simon Tobin will begin his 26th season as Head Men's Soccer Coach at CSUB in the Fall of 2011. 2010 saw Tobin selected as MPSF Coach of the Year. The Roadrunners won the MPSF Pacific Division Title, achieved a national

ranking as high as No. 13, posted the second-highest point total in the conference (18) and recorded a two-spot improvement from the previous season. Tobin also won a Division II National Championship in 1997. Born in London, England, Tobin played for Nonington College, Kent, in 1983, representing Nonington College, Brighton Polytechnic and British Colleges.
